Washing Fabric and Quilts

Washing Fabric

Everyone has an opinion on when and if to wash fabric prior to using it in a quilt. Personally, I have allergies and asthma, so if the fabric I purchase has been stored in a dusty or damp atmosphere, I wash the fabric prior to its use. I also wash the fabric if I have doubts about colorfastness and/or concerns about possible shrinkage...this is just the beginning.
